## Hall of Fame Members: George Thorogood, Ray Price Announced, Cross Canadian Ragweed rescheduled at Mississippi Moon Bar

(Dubuque, IA) George Thorogood will perform at Mississippi Moon Bar at 8 pm on Friday, August 20, 2010. Thorogood is the man behind the hit “Bad to the Bone.” That title track is Thorogood’s best-known composition and its video became a staple on MTV. In 1988 “Born to Be Bad”, was released with the swaggering hit, “You Talk Too Much.” The ‘90s saw more hit-making with 1993’s “Get a Haircut,” from the album Haircut. In 2004 his Greatest Hits: 30 Years of Rock, went gold and was #1 on Billboard’s blues chart for 60 weeks, while winning the magazine’s award for blues record of the year. Reserved seats are \$50 and \$60 each; standing room only tickets are \$30 each. Tickets go on sale Saturday, March 13 at 10 AM.

Ray Price best known for his hits “For the Good Times,” and “Danny Boy,” will perform at Mississippi Moon Bar on Friday, July 9 at 8 pm. Price was inducted into the Country Music Hall of Fame in 1996. He is a two-time Grammy winner and is a legendary country music entertainer. Tickets for his show go on sale at 10 am on Saturday, March 13 at the Diamond Jo Casino’s Diamond Club or at [www.diamondjo.com](http://www.diamondjo.com). Tickets cost \$55 and \$45 for reserved seats and standing room only is \$35.

Cross Canadian Ragweed will perform at Mississippi Moon Bar on Saturday, October 23, 2010. They had originally planned to play May 8 at Mississippi Moon Bar but plans changed when one of the band member’s new baby came unexpectedly early. Considered the last of the great southern rock bands, Cross Canadian Ragweed has hits on both Country and Rock/Pop charts. They recently released their seventh studio album, *Happiness and All the Other Things*. Tickets for Cross Canadian Ragweed cost \$15, \$25 and \$35 and will go on sale at 10 a.m. on Saturday, February 27, 2010.
